### **2014 IPC Powerlifting World Championships Call for Bid Applications**

Dear President/Secretary General,

Following a very successful 2010 IPC Powerlifting World Championships in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, with the largest participation ever in a World Championship we would like to launch the call for bids for the 2014 IPC Powerlifting World Championships.

The Bid application is comprised of three (3) parts:

- Part 1 - General Information
- Part 2 - Questionnaire
- Part 3- Bid Application Appendixes

The deadline to return the above mentioned questionnaire and all other required documentation and guarantees is the **29 June 2012**. Bid applications will only be considered if the application fee of 3,000€ has been transferred to the IPC (bank account details are included in the Bid application documentation) before the date mentioned above.

The Bid application will be reviewed by an Evaluation Commission composed by the IPC Powerlifting Sport Manager and two IPC Powerlifting Technical Committee members. The review will include a minimum of one (1) site visit to each bid by the Commission, and may require a presentation to the Commission.
