

10- Sports Rules and Regulations



In accordance with the Rules of the IAAF and the IPC Athletics Rules and Regulations (2014-2015).

10-1 Classification:

International PI, VI and II classification will be offered. Athlete Classification:

An athlete will only be permitted to undergo classification if he or she:

- Is registered and/or licensed with IPC Athletics pursuant to the relevant provisions in the IPC Athletics Rules and Regulations,
- Has been entered into the Recognised Competition where International

Classification is to take place, and,

• Has provided the required medical diagnostics documentation and uploaded to SDMS.

Where a classification schedule is full,

- Athletes who are licensed will take priority over registered athletes*,
- New Athletes will take priority over Review Athletes.

*Athletes must be licensed prior to the final entry deadline of the respective competition where classification is taking place. Licensing an athlete after the final entry deadline will not give an athlete priority where the schedule is full or has been completed with registered athletes.

At competitions where classification if offered IPC Athletics will schedule all athletes with aNew or Review status and who meet the above requirements for classification where the schedule allows.

If an athlete is scheduled for classification and does not attend, the athlete will not be permitted to compete in the respective competition.

Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF)

Athletes with a Physical (PI) or Visual Impairment (VI)

Medical documentation serves the purpose of providing evidence of an athletes' eligible impairment and is crucial for athlete evaluation and sport class allocation.

The PI and VI MDFs serve the purpose of guiding NPCs in the submission of required medical information for classification. As such, a respective PI/VI MDF must be submitted for all athletes with a New or Review sport class status according to the following deadlines:

- PI MDF and any additional medical reports required as outlined on the form must be uploaded at least 6 weeks before the athlete undergoes classification
- VI MDF and any additional medical reports required as outlined on the form must be uploaded at least 4 weeks before the athlete undergoes classification.

Failure to upload the MDF by the respective deadline may lead to the athlete not being scheduled for classification. Medical Diagnostics Forms can be found here:<u>http://www.paralympic.org/athletics/about/official-documents</u>


Athletes with an Intellectual Impairment (II)

Prior to Athlete Evaluation, an athlete must comply with the following eligibility criteria:

- Inclusion on the INAS Classification Master list
 - You must submit the documents to INAS at least 12 weeks prior to your preferred IPC Athletics classification opportunity
- Completion of the Training History and Sport Limitation Questionnaire (TSAL-Q), available from the IPC Athletics website:<u>http://www.paralympic.org/athletics/about/official-documents</u>. The TSAL-Q form must be uploaded to SDMS using the same procedure as the MDF form.

<u>10-2 Doping Control</u>: Athletes participating to the 9th Tunis International Meeting – 2015 IPC Athletics Grand Prix could be subject to drug testing according to the IPC and WADA rules and regulations.
