### IPC Swimming sponsor on the swimming caps at the 2015 World Championships

Dear NPC Representatives,

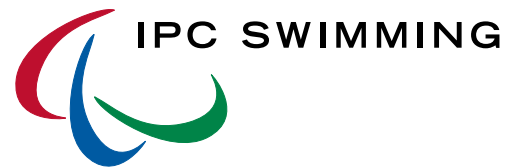
There will be **no** IPC Partner's logo to be placed on the swimming caps at the 2015 IPC Swimming World Championships.

'Right side' is to be understood the following way: when the swimmer is wearing the cap, the logo should be on the right side of his/her head.

On the left side of the cap the athletes shall have the flag and/or country code of the size of 32 cm<sup>2</sup> and the athlete's name of the size of 20 cm<sup>2</sup>. The placing of the IPC Swimming logo is not compulsory. NPCs can decide to leave the right side blank, put the IPC Swimming logo or to put flag and/or country code of the size of 32 cm<sup>2</sup> and the athlete's name of the size of 20 cm<sup>2</sup> on the right side of the cap as well.

The IPC Swimming logo can be found attached in eps format. Please adhere to the following colour combinations:
