(The same venue which was used during Shooting World Cup 2015)

Distance between "Shooting range PAMPAS" and Sport Hall "GRADSKI VRT" is 7 km or 10 minutes driving by bus. The organizers will arrange transportation between the two venues.

*We are still in negotiation to install a big shooting tent on the Shooting range Pampas for air weapon events. In this case all events will be held on the same venue "Shooting range PAMPAS"







SIUS Ascor electronic targets will be used for all events (Qualification and Finals). The range is equipped with up to 40 firing points at 10 metres, 20 at 25 metres and 40 at 50 metres.

Airport

The official airport will be Zagreb Airport. This airport is located 300 kilometres from the venue.

Climate

The average temperature in September in Osijek is 25º Celsius, with max. 28º, min 19º.

4 Preliminary Programme

The provisional timetable and events programme is attached in draft form. Please note there may be changes to the timetable once entries close. The final timetable will be sent following the final entries deadline. Finals will be conducted under current ISSF rules in all events (except R9 & P5).

5 Competition Duration

The competition duration is 5 days plus 2 additional days for International Classification and Equipment Control prior to the start of the competition.

6 Number of Athlete Entries per Event per NPC

The maximum entry per NPC is four (4) 'full' participants per event (athletes eligible to progress to the final, and to obtain direct quota allocation, records and ranking).

NPCs may additionally enter an unlimited number of 'MQS-only' athletes (athletes are eligible to obtain qualification scores to be recognised for MQS, but cannot progress to the event final or obtain direct quota allocation, records or rankings). However, in case of insufficient firing points this number may be restricted by World Shooting Para Sport, in a timely manner. When entering more than 4 athletes to an event via the Online Entry System, the NPC should contact World Shooting Para Sport after making the online entries, confirming which athletes are to be entered as 'full' entry and which as 'MQS-only'.







7 Viability of Events

Individual events are considered viable if they have athletes from four (4) countries entered through the Entry by Number. Team events will be considered viable if they have a minimum of three (3) eligible NPCs entered through the Entry by Number. Otherwise the event is not considered viable and will be cancelled. In cases where only 3 teams participate, medals will be awarded according to the minus-one rule.

8 International classification

International Classification will be conducted on September 2017. A detailed classification schedule will follow after the revision of the final entries by World Shooting Para Sport. At least 4 weeks prior to classification the athlete's completed IPC Medical Information Form and Classification Consent Form must have been uploaded to the athlete's SDMS profile, these form can be found on the World Shooting Para Sport website: www.paralympic.org/shooting/teams/downloads

9 Results, Rankings & Records

After the competition is finished, results will be reviewed and published on the World Shooting Para Sport website and the Ranking and Records lists will be updated accordingly.

World Shooting Para Sport shall maintain world and regional rankings based on the final results list. Only athletes that are licensed, have a sport class status Review (R) or Confirmed (C) and reach the rankings cut-off standard for the relevant event, will have their results recognised for ranking purposes.

11 MQS Allocation

MQS scores for the 2018 World Championships can be achieved at this competition. For further details, please refer to the 2018 World Championships Qualification Guide.

12 Entries and Registration Process

All entered athletes must be licensed by the final entries deadline. Athletes' entries not meeting this criteria will be rejected by World Shooting Para Sport.

All athletes must be entered by their respective NPCs or authorised organisations by the NPC and accepted by World Shooting Para Sport.

All NPCs must declare their entries within the given deadline. No late entries are to be accepted.

Replacement entries may be accepted in the same event only due to injury or medical reason. The NPC must submit support documents to World Shooting Para Sport office for approval. The LOC must also approve if such late changes can be accommodated (e.g. firearms import arrangements).

The registration process for the competition is as follows:

15 July 2017	First Entry (by number) Deadline, via the IPC Online Entry System (www.paralympic.org/entries)
16 July 2017	Opening of the Online Final Entry system (www.paralympic.org/entries), confirmation of competition basic entry fee & release of final entry booking forms
18 August 2017	Final Entry Deadline , including submission of all forms and transfer of payment.
25 August 2017	Final Payment Deadline

13 Entry Fee

BASIC ENTRY FEE PACKAGE:

The basic entry fee package is **1.450, 00 EUR per person**. This is fully inclusive of:

- Accomodation: **8 nights** (Check in 19 September, Check out: 27 September) -Price is based on two persons sharing the room
- Catering
- Including meals, starting with dinner on arrival day and finishing with breakfast on departure day
- Competition service fee (covering costs including shooting range hire, electronic targets, Competition Officials, etc);
- Transport on relation Hotel Shooting Range Hotel
- Closing banquet (26th September).

Additional payment 80,00 EUR per person for Transport - (Zagreb airport - Hotel Osijek - Zagreb airport)

MINIMUM ENTRY FEE PACKAGE:

The minimum entry fee package is 1.000, 00 EUR per person.

This package includes:

- a) Accommodation: 5 NIGHTS (price is based on two persons sharing the room)
- b) **Meals,** starting with dinner on arrival day and finishing with breakfast on departure day
- c) Competition service fee (covering costs including range hire, electronic targets, Competition Officials, etc);
- d) Transport on relation Hotel Shooting Range Hotel
- e) Closing banquet (26 September).







Additional payment for Transport of 80, 00 EUR per person is needed for those participants that need transport - (Zagreb airport - Hotel Osijek - Zagreb airport)

Price for Extra day (above these 5 nights from minimum entry package) is **180, 00 Euro** per person per night (price is based on two persons sharing the room)

Single rooms are available on request and with additional payment of EUR **75**, **00** per person per day.

Event Entry Fees

In addition to the entry fee, the following competition event entry fees will be charged:

- Individual events: EUR 10 per athlete entry per individual event
- Team events: EUR 20 per team entry per team event

A new policy since 2014, these event entry fees will be collected by the LOC on behalf of World Shooting Para Sport. World Shooting Para Sport will reinvest this collected revenue into the development of the sport.

Payment

LOC will calculate the total entry and competition fees and send an invoice with bank details.

The amount of the Entry fee invoice must be paid by the Final Payment Deadline (25 August 2017).

All fees must be paid by bank transfer in EURO, and any bank fees or charges MUST be paid by the payee on top of the balance at the time of payment.

Cancellations

In case of cancellation of participation after final entry deadline, the NPC must pay in full the Entry fee based on their Final Entry submitted.

14 Accommodation

The official Championships hotels are:

- 1) Hotel Osijek(****) in Osijek;
- 2) Hotel Lav**** in Vukovar, 35 km distance from Osijek;
- 3) Hotel Patria**** in Beli Manastir, 30 km distance from Osijek.

All participants will be accommodated in Hotel Osijek or in one of the above official Championships hotels (on request or with agreement with the organizer). All three hotels offer 4* level services and are friendly for wheelchair users with few fully adapted rooms. Accommodation is offered in double bedrooms, some rooms are twin rooms, the other are double with queen beds.

Due to limited number of twin-bed rooms, the twin rooms will be distributed on first come first serve basis.

Single rooms are available on request and with additional payment of EUR 75,00 per person per day.

The Basic Entry Fee covers accommodation from 19 to 27 September . For extra days (those participants who wish to check in before 18 September and / or check out after 27th September), an additional payment of EUR 180 per person / day (for those accommodated in double rooms)

All bookings must be made through the LOC: according to received Accommodation Forms, the LOC will make booking of the rooms and charge the NPC for Entry Fee.

The Competition services related to accommodation, transport, accreditation, information desk is offered only to the teams accommodated in official championships hotels.







15 Catering

Hotel service is based on Breakfast and Dinner in the Hotel restaurants:

- Breakfast starting with September 20th until breakfast on September 27th.
- Dinner services starting with dinner on September 19th until dinner on September 26th.

Lunch will be served on the venue – buffet service from September 20th till September 26th

16 Transport

Transport from Zagreb airport to Osijek (300 km) is about 4 hours of travelling. Airport transfers will be organized with adequate buses or minivans (depending of arrival schedule of the teams).

The travelling time from hotel Osijek to shooting ranges will be max. 15 minutes each way with accessible busses and/or minivans.

The travelling time from hotel Lav to shooting ranges will be max. 40 minutes each way with accessible busses and/or minivans.

There will be scheduled 2 or 3 departures from the hotel daily accordingly to the competition schedule.

17 Import of firearms

When entering Croatia, you will need to have an invitation letter and claim possession of the firearms to the officer when crossing the border.

- Persons with EU firearm permits do not need to show any forms or pay any taxes.
- All persons arriving from outside the EU will get an official form from police when crossing the border, where they can enter requested data for up-to three weapons. The tax of 105 Croatian Kuna (cca 15 EUR) is requested for every submitted form.

<u>Upon arrival</u> to Croatia all firearms and ammunition must be transported directly to the Shooting range firearms storage.

<u>At departure</u> the firearms and ammunition have to be collected from the firearms storage on the way to airport (not before).







18 Visas

NPCs are responsible to obtain a visa if needed. Please contact the organisers for the official invitation letter. You can find information about Visas between Croatia and other countries here: http://www.mvep.hr/en/foreign-politics/bilateral-relations/overview-by-country

For those needing a visa a letter of invitation will be provided by the organisers with the following details when the following is provided:

- 1. Full name as in passport
- 2. Function in the team
- 3. Passport number
- 4. Passport expiry date
- 5. Copy of Passport (Clear to see)

19 Insurance

Please kindly note that all team members (including competitors, technical staff, officials and supporters) attending this event are kindly requested to ensure they have personal, medical and travel insurance as the event will not indemnify individual claims.

20 Doping

Doping control will be conducted according to the IPC Anti-Doping Code.

21 Medical

Medical and First Aid support will be available at the event. Specific medical requirements should be provided by the individual or requested in advance by the Final Entry deadline. Every effort will be made to meet requirements.
