

World Para Snowboard Competitions Season 2018/2019

Athletes who have achieved qualification criteria from 1 July 2018 onwards maintain qualification status for the entire competition season.

Athletes who achieve qualification criteria during the competition season will maintain the qualification for the remainder of that competition season.

Athlete must be internationally classified with either a 'Confirmed' or 'Review 2019' sport class status.

Athletes must have a valid 2018/19 World Para Snowboard licence and classification status to be considered to compete.

1. World Para Snowboard World Cups

For Snowboard Cross:

- Men must have a minimum of 100 World Para Snowboard points in Snowboard Cross,
- Women must have a minimum of 100 World Para Snowboard points in Snowboard Cross,

For Banked Slalom and Dual Banked Slalom:

- Men must have a minimum of 100 World Para Snowboard points in Snowboard Cross or Banked Slalom or Dual Banked Slalom.
- Women must have a minimum of 100 World Para Snowboard points in Snowboard Cross or Banked Slalom or Dual Banked Slalom.

1.1 World Para Snowboard World Cup Women Upper Limb special criteria

For Snowboard Cross:

• UL Women must have a minimum of 50 World Para Snowboard points in Snowboard Cross,

For Banked Slalom and Dual Banked Slalom:

• UL Women must have a minimum of 30 World Para Snowboard points in Snowboard Cross or Banked Slalom or Dual Banked Slalom.

NOTE: UL Women can be granted slot on World Cup event based on performances on first official training day prior World Cup SBX race. Jury is responsible for this decision.



1.2 World Para Snowboard World Cups wild cards application

For Snowboard Cross, Banked Slalom and Dual Banked Slalom:

• Based on athletes' performance on pre World Cup event (Continental Cup back to back with World Cup event) the Jury will decide on direct wild cars for World Cup event.

2. World Para Snowboard Continental Cup

World Para Snowboard Continental Cups will remain open for all athletes with a valid World Para Snowboard licence and classification status.
